Grapes: Pinot Noir, Seyval Blanc, Chardonnay

Region: Staffordshire

Tasting Notes: A classic blend of English varieties, showing a pale gold colour in the glass, with a delicate mousse, and fine, free-flowing bubbles. Pinot Noir brings in elegant characters and mouth-feel, whilst Chardonnay adds delicate apple and lemon flavours, and Seyval Blanc keeps the blend crisp and exciting. Over 18 months of bottle age adds developed brioche and hazelnut characters to create a rich and complex wine. Perfect for all occasions, but pairs brilliantly with oysters, crab, or fish and chips.
